PROFESSIONALS IN GLASS ART INSTRUCTION

****Please register in advance . Fees must be paid at time of registration. ****

*****Call at least two days in advance of the class to confirm schedule time if you have not received a confirmation of the class you have signed up for. Refunds can be provided for cancelled classes. Fees will be forfeited for no-shows. A minimum of 5 students is needed to begin a class, maximum of 8 in any one class. Call early to reserve your spot. For safety reasons, open toe shoes & shorts are not allowed. Please bring safety glasses to class. (we do sell glasses if you do not have a pair.) Cancellations must be made 48 hrs in advance to receive a refund.**

BEGINNING STAINED GLASS CLASS - 4 WEEK OR 2 DAY PROGRAM No basic skills are required for this class. *Caution - stained glass is addictive!*

This is our core program. You will learn the **CORRECT** techniques of the "Tiffany" style stained glass fabrication from professionals along with glass selection, cutting and soldering. You will complete a window hanging with an approximate size of 10" x 15". Class fee of \$175.00 includes the best glass cutter on the market, breaking tools and instruction. Materials are extra (approximately \$20.00-\$40.00). While in this class you do receive a discount on your tools, glass and supplies.

2-DAY, SATURDAYS, September 13 & 20 from 9am to 2pm

2-DAY, SATURDAYS, November 1 & 15 from 9am to 2pm

INTERMEDIATE CLASS - TWO DAYS

You must have beginning class and/or experience to attend this class. We will cover various topics such as when to reinforce your project, how to set up a 'jig' to make multitudes of the same geometric shapes that are all the same, how to eliminate the need for 'pattern' pieces, how to start your window or door, etc. You must supply your own tools and supplies. You may work on a piece of your choice, however, depending on the size of the class (we take up to 8 people), we will need to discuss with you the size of your project. Class fee for both days is \$85.00

2-DAY, SATURDAYS, September 27 & October 4 from 9am to 1pm

PANEL LAMP CLASS - TWO DAYS

You must have prior experience in both cutting and soldering for this class. You will learn the basics of constructing a panel lamp. Class fee is \$150.00 which includes glass, bevels, copper foil and lamp cap. You will need your own tools, solder and flux for this class.

INTRODUCTION TO USING LEAD CAME

Now that you've learned the Tiffany style of copper foil fabrication, round out your art glass IQ by learning how to work with lead. You will complete a project in just one day. Bring your own cutter, pliers, soldering iron, solder, flux and rheostat. Class fee of \$85.00 covers glass, pattern, lead and cement.

ONE DAY CLASS, SATURDAY, October 18 from 9am to 2p

BEGINNING GLASS BEAD MAKING CLASS

Kris will be having this class and share with you the knowledge she has learned from taking classes from the world known bead maker, Cindy Jenkins plus her own experiences. The cost of this class is \$175.00 and is all inclusive, including the "Hot Head Torch" and all the tools and supplies to make beads in this class and you take the tools and glass home to create your own one of a kind beads. There will be a short lunch break.

SATURDAY, November 15 from 9am to 2p

ADVANCED BEAD MAKING CLASSES NOW OFFERED

Kris will expand on intricate details on your beads. Learn how to create more detail on your beads, such as flowers, how to encase silver leaf/gold leaf, making larger beads, etc. Class fee of \$125.00 will include instruction and supplies such as dichroic stringers, silver leaf, filigrana rods, frit, etc.

SUNDAY, November 16 from 9am to 2pm

BEGINNING FUSING CLASSES

The class will cover topics such as kilns, molds, tools needed, and glass compatibility. You will make both a pendant and a small tile. The fee of \$45.00 includes instruction and all glass needed for your projects.

MOSAIC TABLE TOP

You must sign up in advance to pick up your wood top and seal it before the class begins.
