INTRO TO STAINED GLASS - BEGINNING --NOT SURE IF YOU WANT TO 'INVEST' IN TOOLS? NEW!

This class is just one session of five hours for BEGINNERS who have never cut glass or soldered. You will learn the simple basics of glass cutting and soldering to complete a small project. Class cost is \$35.00 and the supply fee is \$55.00 for: glass, bevel cluster, solder, flux etc. There is no need to buy tools; you can use our tools for this class.

SATURDAY, JANUARY 21 FROM 9AM TO 2PM

BEGINNING STAINED GLASS CLASS - 2 DAY PROGRAM No basic skills are required for this class. *Caution - stained glass is addictive!*

This is our core program. You will learn the **CORRECT** techniques of the "Tiffany" style (copper foil method) stained glass fabrication from professionals along with glass selection, cutting and soldering. You will complete a window hanging with an approximate size of 10" x 15". Unlike the "Intro to Glass Class", we cover all shapes of cutting glass, how to make your pattern pieces, etc. This class is for those of you who know they want to continue in the hobby of stained glass. Class fee of \$175.00 includes the best glass cutter on the market, breaking tools and instruction. Materials are extra (approximately \$20.00-\$50.00). While in this class you do receive a 10% discount on your tools, glass and supplies.
